What is Financial Aid?

Financial Aid is an umbrella term that includes

Loans

Scholarship

Any funds that do not come from you personally





Aid Eligibility

High School Diploma or Equivalent




Steps to Receiving Aid:



Apply for an FSA ID at fsaid.ed.gov







Types of Aid: Loans

Federal Direct Loans

Federal Graduate PLUS Loan x(Credit check required)



Explanation of Loans

Federal Direct loans — no credit check
In the student's name
Repayment begins 6 months after student is no longer enrolled at least half-time (3 credits)

This is an <u>unsubsidized</u> loan:

Interest accrues while student is enrolled Fixed rate of 4.3%(1.059% origination fee)

Students must go to www.studentaid.gov
and sign their master promissory note and complete entrance counseling in order for loans to pay against the bill



Explanation of Loans

Federal Graduate PLUS Ioan

Based on credit check

Endorser (co-signer) if necessary

5.3% interest rate (4.236% origination fee)

Repayment Options:

- 1. Standard immediate repayment
- 2. Interest only payments
- 3. Full deferment



Explanation of Loans

Private loans

provided through lenders such as banks or educational loan lenders

- Review Interest Rates and Repayment Terms
- Truth in Lending Act requires a number of steps to be taken by the borrower and the lender before a loan can be disbursed
 - Private loans can take up a month or more to process


